***(bolded verses were briefly mentioned and described in 9-1-24 Sermon;

**Gen 19:1 ESV - The two angels came to Sodom in the evening, and Lot was sitting in the gate of Sodom. When Lot saw them, he rose to meet them and bowed himself with his face to the earth**

Gen 19:15 ESV - As morning dawned, the angels urged Lot, saying, "Up! Take your wife and your two daughters who are here, lest you be swept away in the punishment of the city."

Gen 28:12 ESV - And he dreamed, and behold, there was a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven. And behold, the angels of God were ascending and descending on it!

Gen 32:1 ESV - Jacob went on his way, and the angels of God met him.

Job 4:18 ESV - Even in his servants he puts no trust, and his angels he charges with error;

Psa 78:25 ESV - Man ate of the bread of the angels; he sent them food in abundance.

Psa 78:49 ESV - He let loose on them his burning anger, wrath, indignation, and distress, a company of destroying angels.

Psa 91:11 ESV - For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways.

**Psa 103:20 ESV - Bless the LORD, O you his angels, you mighty ones who do his word, obeying the voice of his word!**

**Psa 148:2 ESV - Praise him, all his angels; praise him, all his hosts!**

**Mat 4:6 ESV - and said to him, "If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down, for it is written, "'He will command his angels concerning you,' and "'On their hands they will bear you up, lest you strike your foot against a stone.'"**

**Mat 4:11 ESV - Then the devil left him, and behold, angels came and were ministering to him.**

Mat 13:39 ESV - and the enemy who sowed them is the devil. The harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are angels.

Mat 13:41 ESV - The Son of Man will send his angels, and they will gather out of his kingdom all causes of sin and all law-breakers,

Mat 13:49 ESV - So it will be at the end of the age. The angels will come out and separate the evil from the righteous

**Mat 16:27 ESV - For the Son of Man is going to come with his angels in the glory of his Father, and then he will repay each person according to what he has done.**

**Mat 18:10 ESV - "See that you do not despise one of these little ones. For I tell you that in heaven their angels always see the face of my Father who is in heaven.**

Mat 22:30 ESV - For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven.

Mat 24:31 ESV - And he will send out his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

Mat 24:36 ESV - "But concerning that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father only.

Mat 25:31 ESV - "When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne.

**Mat 25:41 ESV - "Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels.**

Mat 26:53 ESV - Do you think that I cannot appeal to my Father, and he will at once send me more than twelve legions of angels?

Mar 1:13 ESV - And he was in the wilderness forty days, being tempted by Satan. And he was with the wild animals, and the angels were ministering to him.

Mar 8:38 ESV - For whoever is ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him will the Son of Man also be ashamed when he comes in the glory of his Father with the holy angels."

Mar 12:25 ESV - For when they rise from the dead, they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven.

Mar 13:27 ESV - And then he will send out the angels and gather his elect from the four winds, from the ends of the earth to the ends of heaven.

Mar 13:32 ESV - "But concerning that day or that hour, no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.

Luk 2:15 ESV - When the angels went away from them into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "Let us go over to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has made known to us."

Luk 4:10 ESV - for it is written, "'He will command his angels concerning you, to guard you,'

Luk 9:26 ESV - For whoever is ashamed of me and of my words, of him will the Son of Man be ashamed when he comes in his glory and the glory of the Father and of the holy angels.

Luk 12:8 ESV - "And I tell you, everyone who acknowledges me before men, the Son of Man also will acknowledge before the angels of God,

Luk 12:9 ESV - but the one who denies me before men will be denied before the angels of God.

Luk 15:10 ESV - Just so, I tell you, there is joy before the angels of God over one sinner who repents."

Luk 16:22 ESV - The poor man died and was carried by the angels to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried,

Luk 20:36 ESV - for they cannot die anymore, because they are equal to angels and are sons of God, being sons of the resurrection.

Luk 24:23 ESV - and when they did not find his body, they came back saying that they had even seen a vision of angels, who said that he was alive.

Jhn 1:51 ESV - And he said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, you will see heaven opened, and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man."

Jhn 20:12 ESV - And she saw two angels in white, sitting where the body of Jesus had lain, one at the head and one at the feet.

**Act 7:53 ESV - you who received the law as delivered by angels and did not keep it."**

Rom 8:38 ESV - For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers,

1Co 4:9 ESV - For I think that God has exhibited us apostles as last of all, like men sentenced to death, because we have become a spectacle to the world, to angels, and to men.

**1Co 6:3 ESV - Do you not know that we are to judge angels? How much more, then, matters pertaining to this life!**

**1Co 11:10 ESV - That is why a wife ought to have a symbol of authority on her head, because of the angels.**

**1Co 13:1 ESV - If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal.**

**Gal 3:19 ESV - Why then the law? It was added because of transgressions, until the offspring should come to whom the promise had been made, and it was put in place through angels by an intermediary.**

**Col 2:18 ESV - Let no one disqualify you, insisting on asceticism and worship of angels, going on in detail about visions, puffed up without reason by his sensuous mind,**

**2Th 1:7 ESV - and to grant relief to you who are afflicted as well as to us, when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with his mighty angels**

**1Ti 3:16 ESV - Great indeed, we confess, is the mystery of godliness: He was manifested in the flesh, vindicated by the Spirit, seen by angels, proclaimed among the nations, believed on in the world, taken up in glory.**

**1Ti 5:21 ESV - In the presence of God and of Christ Jesus and of the elect angels I charge you to keep these rules without prejudging, doing nothing from partiality.**

Heb 1:4 ESV - having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs.

Heb 1:5 ESV - For to which of the angels did God ever say, "You are my Son, today I have begotten you"? Or again, "I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son"?

Heb 1:6 ESV - And again, when he brings the firstborn into the world, he says, "Let all God's angels worship him."

**Heb 1:7 ESV - Of the angels he says, "He makes his angels winds, and his ministers a flame of fire."**

Heb 1:13 ESV - And to which of the angels has he ever said, "Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet"?

**Heb 2:2 ESV - For since the message declared by angels proved to be reliable, and every transgression or disobedience received a just retribution,**

Heb 2:5 ESV - For it was not to angels that God subjected the world to come, of which we are speaking.

Heb 2:7 ESV - You made him for a little while lower than the angels; you have crowned him with glory and honor,

Heb 2:9 ESV - But we see him who for a little while was made lower than the angels, namely Jesus, crowned with glory and honor because of the suffering of death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone.

**Heb 2:16 ESV - For surely it is not angels that he helps, but he helps the offspring of Abraham.**

**Heb 12:22 ESV - But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to innumerable angels in festal gathering,**

**Heb 13:2 ESV - Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.**

**1Pe 1:12 ESV - It was revealed to them that they were serving not themselves but you, in the things that have now been announced to you through those who preached the good news to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven, things into which angels long to look.**

1Pe 3:22 ESV - who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, authorities, and powers having been subjected to him.

**2Pe 2:4 ESV - For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into hell and committed them to chains of gloomy darkness to be kept until the judgment;**

2Pe 2:11 ESV - whereas angels, though greater in might and power, do not pronounce a blasphemous judgment against them before the Lord.

Jde 1:6 ESV - And the angels who did not stay within their own position of authority, but left their proper dwelling, he has kept in eternal chains under gloomy darkness until the judgment of the great day--

Rev 1:20 ESV - As for the mystery of the seven stars that you saw in my right hand, and the seven golden lampstands, the seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches.

Rev 3:5 ESV - The one who conquers will be clothed thus in white garments, and I will never blot his name out of the book of life. I will confess his name before my Father and before his angels.

**Rev 5:11 ESV - Then I looked, and I heard around the throne and the living creatures and the elders the voice of many angels, numbering myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands,**

Rev 7:1 ESV - After this I saw four angels standing at the four corners of the earth, holding back the four winds of the earth, that no wind might blow on earth or sea or against any tree.

Rev 7:2 ESV - Then I saw another angel ascending from the rising of the sun, with the seal of the living God, and he called with a loud voice to the four angels who had been given power to harm earth and sea,

Rev 7:11 ESV - And all the angels were standing around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures, and they fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God,

Rev 8:2 ESV - Then I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and seven trumpets were given to them.

Rev 8:6 ESV - Now the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared to blow them.

Rev 8:13 ESV - Then I looked, and I heard an eagle crying with a loud voice as it flew directly overhead, "Woe, woe, woe to those who dwell on the earth, at the blasts of the other trumpets that the three angels are about to blow!"

Rev 9:14 ESV - saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, "Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates."

Rev 9:15 ESV - So the four angels, who had been prepared for the hour, the day, the month, and the year, were released to kill a third of mankind.

Rev 12:7 ESV - Now war arose in heaven, Michael and his angels fighting against the dragon. And the dragon and his angels fought back,

Rev 12:9 ESV - And the great dragon was thrown down, that ancient serpent, who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world--he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.

Rev 14:10 ESV - he also will drink the wine of God's wrath, poured full strength into the cup of his anger, and he will be tormented with fire and sulfur in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb.

Rev 15:1 ESV - Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and amazing, seven angels with seven plagues, which are the last, for with them the wrath of God is finished.

Rev 15:6 ESV - and out of the sanctuary came the seven angels with the seven plagues, clothed in pure, bright linen, with golden sashes around their chests.

Rev 15:7 ESV - And one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the wrath of God who lives forever and ever,

Rev 15:8 ESV - and the sanctuary was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from his power, and no one could enter the sanctuary until the seven plagues of the seven angels were finished.

Rev 16:1 ESV - Then I heard a loud voice from the temple telling the seven angels, "Go and pour out on the earth the seven bowls of the wrath of God."

Rev 17:1 ESV - Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came and said to me, "Come, I will show you the judgment of the great prostitute who is seated on many waters,

Rev 21:9 ESV - Then came one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls full of the seven last plagues and spoke to me, saying, "Come, I will show you the Bride, the wife of the Lamb."

Rev 21:12 ESV - It had a great, high wall, with twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and on the gates the names of the twelve tribes of the sons of Israel were inscribed--
